Clubhouse and Golf Course Hours of Operation

Golf Course hours of operation are as follows:

- March, November, and December (weather depending)
- April and October – 8:00am on weekends, 8:30am on weekdays (frost delays possible)
- May through September – 7:30am on weekends, 8:00am on weekdays*

The clubhouse is open from March through December. Reservations are strongly recommended for dining.

During the months of January and February, the clubhouse and golf course are closed - members are permitted to walk during these months if the temperature is over 40 degrees and there is no frost.

House Rules, Dress Code & Food & Beverage Minimums

House Rules:

Each member shall be held responsible for his own conduct and that of family and guests, for any act, manner, or anything prejudicial to the welfare, good order and character of the club. All members, family and guests should treat the Club's employees and staff in all departments in a courteous fashion. Failure to do so may result in the suspension or expulsion of membership privileges.

The Club Manager is empowered to enforce house rules at all times. All facilities of the club are limited to members and their guests. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. Members will be held responsible for the conduct of their guests.

Dress Code:

Golf slacks or appropriate shorts and golf-type shirts (with collars/mock turtlenecks and sleeves) for gentlemen will be considered appropriate. Attire for the ladies includes golf skirts/slacks, golf appropriate length shorts, skirts, and golf-type tops (with or without collars).

Golf attire and fashion shall be consistent with the current golf fashion including that used by the PGA and LPGA tour players.

Certain apparel such as short shorts, cargo shorts, athletic or jogging shorts, cut-off slacks, denim or blue jeans, halter tops and fishnet tops are considered inappropriate. Hats and caps must be worn with the brim forward.

Jeans are permitted in the grill room, but men must wear a shirt with a collar.

Food and Beverage Minimums:

If your classification of membership includes a food and beverage minimum the following schedule is used:

- March through June, F&B minimum is \$450 (\$75 for 6 months)
- July through December, F&B minimum is \$75 for each of the six months

Starting Times and Registering for Play

Tee time reservations are required. Tee times can be reserved for “Golfing Members” one week in advance online, in person, or by phone. Social Members may reserve tee times five days in advance. Unannounced play will be given the next available open starting time. Each member and any guest must register in the Golf Shop before starting play. If a member does not register with the Golf Shop the staff will assume it is an 18-hole with cart fee charge.

- There are no restrictions to times of play for “Golfing Memberships”
- Junior Members are not permitted until noon on Weekends/Holidays unless accompanied by a Golfing Member.
- Social Members may play 5 times per year, applicable charges will be applied, and are not permitted until 11:00am on Weekends/Holidays.

The Golf Committee is responsible for the management of all golf activities. This is accomplished through the Golf Professional and his staff. The Committee also recommends, for Board of Directors approval, the playing rules, times of play, golf attire and establishment of green and cart fees. The Golf Committee is responsible for the entire golf operation. The golfing season is from April 1 through November 14.

Cart Fees

9 - Hole Cart Fee \$15/person, 18 - Hole Cart Fee \$25/person

Golf cart usage will be restricted sometimes based on course conditions. The Course Superintendent decides on cart rules for the day. Golf carts shall remain at least 30 yards away from all greens and tees unless you have a "handicap" flag for your cart. On days that it is mandatory to remain on cart paths handicap flags are not available.

Guest Fees

Anytime Weekdays and Weekend/Holidays after 11:00am - \$70

Anytime Weekdays and Weekend/Holidays after 11:00am - Nine Hole Rate - \$40

Weekend/Holidays before 11:00am - \$85

Weekend/Holidays before 11:00am - Nine Hole Rate - \$45

Cart fees included on all guest rates

Guests are limited to play 5 times per year not counting member events or golf outings

Members are limited to 7 guests per visit. If greater than 7 guests Outing Rates apply

Cash payment is NOT accepted for cart or guest fees

Cart Fee Packages

Unlimited Cart Package - \$1,150 (limited to one individual)

40 Cart Package - \$850 (may be shared within same account)

20 Cart Package - \$450 (may be shared within same account)

Cart Packages must be purchased by May 15, no exceptions will be made

Practice Range

The practice range is very important to improve your game. The range is limited in distance, and we ask that you do not carry your shot any further than 150 yards. A yearly range membership for an individual is \$225 and \$325 for a family. Balls can be purchased individually for \$5 per bag.

Pace of Play

The pace of play for 18 holes is 3 hours and 40 minutes. This requires all members and guests to be aware of their pace of play on the course. If your group falls behind pace, please allow faster groups to play through. If a member of the golf shop staff needs to remind you of your pace, please remember that it is one of our least favorite duties.

Golf Rules

U.S.G.A. rules will govern play at all times. If conditions require any modifications of these rules, a notice will be placed outside of the Golf Shop.

Handicaps

Connoquenessing CC utilizes the USGA's GHIN handicap system. All golfing members are required to have a GHIN number. Each member will be charged a \$40 fee for use of the USGA GHIN service. To post online, download the GHIN handicap score posting app. If you are a new member, please inquire with the golf shop to acquire your GHIN number. All scores must be posted from April 1-November 14. Periodic review of score posting along with any other handicap issues will be handled by CCC's Handicap Committee.

Lightning Policy

The facility does not possess an inclement weather warning or detection system. Golfers are advised that they play at their own risk, and we may not be able to retrieve and/or remove anyone from the golf course due to the inclement weather, including lightning. Connoquenessing CC is not responsible for injuries or damage resulting from inclement weather.



Golf Shop Offerings

Golf Lessons

Golf lessons are available with PGA Professional Frank Blazewick. All lessons are by appointment only. Appointments can be made by calling the golf shop at 724-752-2294 Ext 212 or by emailing Frank at frank.blazewick@connoclub.com.

60-minutes - \$100

30-minutes - \$55

Junior Program

This is a team format playing in a low-pressure scramble match against other local clubs. The program will run from mid-May till the end of July with either a weekly practice or match. Club Storage and Cleaning

We offer club storage and club cleaning service. Our staff cares about giving you a smooth and enjoyable golf experience before and after you play. When you finish, leave your clubs on the cart and they will be cleaned and placed in the bag room. When you come back to play again, they will be ready for you. Club storage is free for all golfing members. Pull cart storage costs \$75 per season and electric cart storage costs \$100 per season.

Locker Facility

There is no fee for a half locker for golfing members. If you want a full-length locker, please let the Golf Shop staff know and you can have one for \$100 per season. The club does not provide locks.



Golf Shop Offerings

Merchandise Club

Yearly raffle that is run through the Golf Shop. It is \$50 for the year. Five winners each month for five months starting in May will be awarded golf shop credit.

Hole-in-One Club

Sign up for the hole-in-one club and \$10 per hole-in-one made through the golfing season (April 1 – November 14) will be charged to your account. If you are in the club and you make a hole in one you will receive \$10 from everyone in the club. (75% cash & 25% in golf shop credit)

Par Quota

Every Wednesday night from April 24th till October 2nd at 5:30pm the “Par Quota” event is held. Please register by 5:15pm, pairings and scorecards will be done by the golf shop and the shotgun will start. Front and Back nines will be alternated weekly. The entry fee is \$15 per week with winnings going to skins, individual play, and team play. Quotas are based off the prior week's scoring.

Couples League

Every other Thursday night from May 9th till September 19th at 6:00pm the “Couples” league will tee off. Please register by 5:45pm, pairings and scorecards will be done by the golf shop and the shotgun will start. The entry fee is \$10 per couple for golfing members and \$20 per couple for non-golfing members. Cart fees do apply. A two-person scramble format is used with family tees encouraged for beginners. There will be team awards along with skill events.

SWAT (Singles Without A Time)

This is a great way to always come out and join a game without setting anything up. Groups are a blind draw, and a team game is usually played. Entry fee is \$20, please arrive at least 15 minutes before the starting time and you will be added to the group. SWAT opportunities are as follows:

- Wednesday and Friday SWAT plays at 1:00pm*
- Saturday and Sunday morning SWAT plays at 8:15am*
- Saturday and Sunday late SWAT plays at 11:00am*
